

AFSCME Council 65 Supports Shared Sacrifice on Pension Reform

AFSCME Council 65's Executive Board voted on March 8, 2017 to support Governor Dayton's policy and budget proposals on pension reform in order to make the PERA Police and Fire and the Minnesota State Retirement System funds fiscally sound. We support the Governor's policy of **shared sacrifice**. We are also willing to continue to work with the Legislative Pension Commission to bring these pension funds to fiscal stability and full funding.

AFSCME Council 65 represents many police officers who belong to PERA Police and Fire. We support the Governor's PERA Police and Fire proposals to:

- increase the employee contribution from 10.8% to 11.3% in Fiscal Year 18 and to 11.8% in Fiscal Year 19.
- eliminate the COLA triggers for retirees so there is not an automatic increase in the COLA's from 1.00% to 2.5%.
- cut the assumed rate of return from 8.00% to 7.5%.

AFSCME Council 65 also represents many state court employees who belong to the Minnesota State Retirement System. We support the Governor's Minnesota State Retirement Association proposals to:

- increase the employee contribution from 5.5% to 6.0%.
- cut the COLA for retirees from 2.0% to 1.5%.
- eliminate the COLA triggers for retirees so there is not an automatic increase in the COLA's to 2.5%.
- cut the assumed rate of return from 8.00% to 7.5%.

AFSCME Council 65 represents 13,000+ public sector and non-profit employees in Greater Minnesota.
