| 1.10 | Subdivision 1. Definitions. (a) For purposes of this section, the terms defined in this |

| 1.12 | (b) "Agaa sistion" maans the Teachans Detinement Agaa sistion |
| 1.13 | (b) "Association" means the Teachers Retirement Association. |
| 1.14 | (c) "Board of trustees" means the governing board of Minnesota State. |
| 1.15 | (d) "Executive director" means the executive director of the association. |

| 1.19 | Subd. 2. Authority to transfer coverage. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the |
| 1.20 | contrary, an eligible person described in subdivision 3 is authorized to become a member |
| 1.21 | of the association and receive credit for past service and salary upon making an election |
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| 2.1 | under subdivision 4 and making the required contribution and paying the administrative |
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| 2.2 | fee, if any, under subdivision 5. |
| 2.3 | Subd. 3. Eligible person. (a) An eligible person is a person who: |
| 2.4 | (1) is or was employed by Minnesota State or a community college, technical college, |

| 2.7 | (3) if first employed by Minnesota State on or after July 1, 1994, had the right to elect |

| 3.11 | the eligible person of the amounts required and options for making the payments. |
| 3.12 | (b) The employee contribution amount is equal to the excess, if any, of the employee |
| 3.13 | contributions that the eligible person would have made if covered by the association for the |

| 3.17 | (c) The executive director may pass on the costs of calculating the payment amount |

| 3.20 | (d) If, upon receipt of the notice regarding the amounts determined under paragraphs |
| 3.21 | (b) and (c), the eligible employee desires to complete the process of transferring coverage |

| 4.5 | solely for the purpose of granting past service and salary credit in computing the eligible |

| 4.21 | Subd. 9. Plan account must be intact. An eligible person may elect coverage by the |

| 4.24 | rollover distribution of all or any portion of the eligible person's account in the plan. |
