## Possible Legislation, Work Groups, and Topics for Study 2023-2024 Interim

April 12, 2023

## **Required**:

- Work group on transfers from the MN State IRAP to TRA
- Work with PERA to draft legislation to add a defined contribution component to the **Statewide Volunteer Firefighter Plan** and make other changes to make the plan more attractive to relief associations
- Prepare legislation consisting of the rest of the recommended legislation from the **State Auditor's Fire Relief Working Group**, including eliminating the word "volunteer" from most of the volunteer firefighter relief association chapter (424A)
- Prepare legislation to amend **PERA** chapters to bring uniformity to the treatment of **survivor benefits**
- Prepare legislation to expand eligibility to the **PERA Defined Contribution Plan** and fix noncompliant provisions
- Assessment of pension bills not heard by the Commission during the 2023 session

## Discretionary:

- Finalize proposed legislation to move the actuarial assumption for investment rate of return from the statutes to the appendix to the Standards where changes would be approved by the Commission rather than the legislature
- Update the Standards for Actuarial Work
- Assess the need for, effectiveness of, and compliance with filing and documentation requirements and limits on employer contributions under Section 356.24, subdivision 3, relating to supplemental retirement plans, including **403(b)** plans and other deferred compensation plans
- Assess the need for, modification of, and compliance with the limits on employer contributions to **multiemployer plans** under Section 356.24, subdivision 1
- Prepare legislation to supplement and clarify statutes imposing **federal tax code requirements** generally applicable to MN's tax-qualified pension and defined contribution plans
- Prepare legislation extending the time period for making **transfers of past service credit** from a general plan to a public safety or correctional plan (to reduce or eliminate the need for special legislation)

## 2023-2024 Interim

- Study the feasibility and impact of requiring employers to contribute the **actuarially determined contribution (ADC)** each year rather than the statutorily required contribution
- Study the appropriateness of charging members **interest at 7.5%** (the assumed rate of return) on repayments of refunds and other payments rather than a lower rate
- Prepare legislation changing the **sunset date for all state aids** and supplemental employer contributions to mirror the changes made by MSRS (sunset only if the funded threshold is exceeded for three years)
- Prepare legislation to change fixed rate COLAs for all plans to **tie COLAs to the Social Security COLA**, with a floor and a cap, to mirror the changes made to the PERA General and Correctional Plans
- Recodify, clean up, clarify, and update terminology in the following chapters, in order of priority:
  - PERA Defined Contribution Plan (353D)
  - MSRS Unclassified Plan (352D)
  - St. Paul Teachers Retirement Fund Association (354A)
  - Retirement Systems, Generally (356)
