LCPR Board,

I ask you to remove executive Jay Stoffel from his membership in the TRA Fund or remove him from his position of executive director because of his conflict of interest.

The current executive director is a Tier I member of the TRA Pension Fund and has unlimited access to legislators and influence over the direction of the fund. Last year, TRA, under the direction of the Executive Director, sent a flyer to key legislators because Tier I was not originally included in the benefit improvements for Tier II members (NRA Change to 64), despite Tier I having a vastly superior retirement age and benefit. This, along with the FACT that the executive has a personal financial stake in the fund, should be enough to remove the executive director from the fund. Any Tier II improvements, in theory, would pose a higher risk to his future personal finances.
