

1.1 moves to amend S.F. No. 3828; H.F. No. 3512, as amended by S3828-1A,
1.2 as follows:

1.3 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.4 "Section 1. **TRANSFER OF MAPLE PLAIN FIRE DEPARTMENT RECORDS,**
1.5 **ASSETS, AND LIABILITIES FROM THE STATEWIDE VOLUNTEER**
1.6 **FIREFIGHTER PLAN.**

1.7 (a) No later than 60 days after the effective date, the executive director of the Public
1.8 Employees Retirement Plan must transfer the records, assets, and liabilities of the Maple
1.9 Plain fire department to the Maple Plain Fire Relief Association and the trust established
1.10 by the Maple Plain Fire Relief Association.

1.11 (b) Minnesota Statutes, section 353G.17, applies to the transfer under paragraph (a)
1.12 except as modified by clauses (1) to (9) of this paragraph.

1.13 (1) Subdivision 1, paragraph (b), clause (3), does not apply.

1.14 (2) Subdivision 1, paragraphs (c) and (d), do not apply.

1.15 (3) Subdivision 2, paragraph (a), clause (2), does not apply.

1.16 (4) Subdivision 2, paragraphs (b) and (c), do not apply.

1.17 (5) Subdivision 3, paragraph (a), is revised to require that the vote be conducted by the
1.18 board of trustees of the Maple Plain Fire Relief Association, rather than the executive director
1.19 of the Public Employees Retirement Association, and that the vote by members of the Maple
1.20 Plain Fire Relief Association must occur no earlier than four months before the effective
1.21 date and no later than 30 days after the effective date.

1.22 (6) Subdivision 3, paragraphs (c) to (e), do not apply.

1.23 (7) Subdivision 4, paragraph (a), is revised to require the Statewide Volunteer Firefighter
1.24 Plan to make the transfer described in paragraph (a) upon completion of the actions required
1.25 under Minnesota Statutes, section 353G.17, subdivisions 1 to 3, as revised by this section,
1.26 and to replace "as of the effective date identified in the notice under subdivision 1," with
1.27 "no later than 60 days after the effective date".

1.28 (8) Subdivision 5, paragraph (d), is revised to add at the end of paragraph (d): "For the
1.29 purpose of this section, the "value" of a firefighter's benefit means the amount determined
1.30 by multiplying the firefighter's years of service by the benefit level applicable to the
1.31 firefighter as determined under Minnesota Statutes, section 424B.22."

2.1 (9) Subdivision 6 is revised to delete the phrase "or the requirements of subdivision 2,
2.2 paragraph (b), are not met."

2.3 **Sec. 2. PENSION PAYMENTS AND PLAN TERMINATION.**

2.4 Upon completion of the transfer of records, assets, and liabilities under section 1 to the
2.5 Maple Plain Fire Relief Association, the Maple Plain Fire Relief Association must make
2.6 pension benefit payments in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 424B.22, as
2.7 amended and in effect on the date payments are made, and subsequently terminate and
2.8 dissolve the relief association in accordance with Minnesota law.

2.9 **Sec. 3. PAYMENT OF SUPPLEMENTAL BENEFITS.**

2.10 (a) The city of Maple Plain is authorized, but not required, to pay supplemental benefits
2.11 due under Minnesota Statutes, section 424A.10, to each qualified recipient or survivor, as
2.12 defined in section 424A.10, of the Maple Plain Fire Relief Association. If the city of Maple
2.13 Plain pays supplemental benefits, the city is eligible for reimbursement from the
2.14 commissioner of revenue under Minnesota Statutes, section 424A.10, for the amount of
2.15 supplemental benefits paid.

2.16 (b) If the city of Maple Plain pays supplemental benefits due under Minnesota Statutes,
2.17 section 424A.10, as authorized by paragraph (a), the Maple Plain Fire Relief Association
2.18 is deemed to have satisfied the requirement under Minnesota Statutes, section 424A.10 to
2.19 pay supplemental benefits.

2.20 **Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2.21 Sections 1 to 3 are effective the day following final enactment."
