MINUTES

Rep. Sarna opened the meeting.

Rep. Sarna, chairman, opened the meeting.

HF 567 (Olsen); SF): Teacher Funds: Designation of Beneficiary for Optional Annuity

The bill authorizes certain types of survivor benefit coverage to be provided to a designated beneficiary instead of only a surviving spouse. It also requires public pension funds to provide information concerning optional annuity forms and requires the signature of the spouse of a member on the retirement annuity.

Nina Rothchild, Economic Status of Women, spoke in opposition to HF 567.

Rep. S. Olson advised the Commission that the bill was requested because of second marriages. Under present law, money cannot be left to surviving children.

John Chenoweth, Exec. Dir. of the Minneapolis Municipal Employees Retirement Association, suggested that all the funds be included in this bill.

Rep. Kaley moved the staff amendment. Motion carried.

Rep. Kaley moved that HF 567 as amended be recommended to pass. Motion carried

HF 82 (Stumpf); SF 62 (Hanson): Police Survivor Benefits in the City of Thief River Falls. Bill increases the amounts to be paid as survivor benefits for Thief River Falls Police. A staff amendment adds language which would require the City of Thief River Falls to amortize.

Sen. Donald Moe moved the staff amendment. Motion Carried
Sen. Donald Moe moved to recommend the bill to pass as amended. Motion Carried

HF 882 (Byrne); SF): St. Paul Firefighters Relief Association:
Specifying the Investment authority of the relief association.

The bill amends the special law governing the investment authority governing the St. Paul Firefighters relief association to specifically provide that the fund is governed by the general law which governs all local police and salaried firefighters relief associations.

Rep. Rice moved the staff amendment and the bill as amended. Motion carried

HF 694 (McEachern); SF): PERA: Minimum Salary Requirement
Maximum salary amounts are to be increased from \$250 per month to \$325 per
month or from \$3,000 per year to \$3,900 per year if the annual compensation
limit is stipulated in advance.

Rep. Reding moved the staff amendment. Motion Carried
Rep. Reding moved to recommend HF 694 to pass as amended. Motion Carried

HF 681 (Reding); SF 974 (Frederickson): Minnesota Post Retirement Investment Fund; Amount of Interest Available for Increases.

Bill amends Minnesota Statutes, Section 11A.18, Subd. 9, which governs the calculation of the amounts of a post retirement adjustment from the Minnesota post retirement investment fund. It modifies the period of time over which a deficiency in the assets of the Minnesota post retirement investment fund when compared to the actuarially determined required reserves will be retired, by reducing from 25 percent to five percent the amount of interest income in excess of the actuarial requirement which will be deducted from the amount available to pay post retirement adjustments.

Sen. Collin Peterson moved to recommend that HF 681; SF 974 be recommended to pass. Motion Carried

HF 976; (Sarna); SF (): MTRFA; Establishment of Post Retirement Adjustment Mechanism. The bill authorizes the Minneapolis Teachers Retirement Fund to establish a post retirement adjustment program for the payment of annual lump sum increases to annuitants and survivor benefit recipients who have been receiving an annuity or survivor benefit for at least five years. It also authorizes MTRFA to provide for the purchase of service credit for periods of authorized parental leave.

HF 976 was recommended to pass as amended.
